

HOPE Scholarship Rigor Requirements Class of 2015 and beyond

Students must receive credit in a MINIMUM of **4** of the following types of courses prior to graduation:

- Advanced math, such as Advanced Algebra and Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, or an equivalent or high course taken at an eligible high school or taken for degree level credit at an eligible postsecondary institution;
- Advanced science, such as Chemistry, Human Anatomy and Physiology, or an equivalent or high course taken at an eligible high school or taken for degree level credit at an eligible postsecondary institution;
- Advanced placement courses in core subjects;
- International baccalaureate courses in core subjects;
- Courses taken at a unit of the University System of Georgia in core subjects where such courses are not remedial and developmental courses; or
- Advanced foreign language courses, such as Spanish II, Spanish III, or Russian II, taken at an eligible high school or taken for degree level credit at an eligible postsecondary institution.

You must also meet GPA requirements to qualify for the
HOPE Scholarship or the **Zell Miller Scholarship**.
