PURPOSE:

The Piedmont Hospital McDuffie Auxiliary Scholarship for Health-Related Careers is designed to provide funds that will encourage individuals to pursue a health-related career.

VALUE:

Two \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY:

The applicants selected:

- (1) Must intend to pursue a health-related career for which the hospital could employ.
- (2) Must be a resident of the counties served by the hospital.
- (2) Must be accepted by a school prior to applying for the scholarship.
(Attach acceptance letter)
- (3) Must be active in community, church, and /or extra-curricular activities.
(Provide list of community and extra-curricular activities)

SCHOLARSHIP:

- (1) The value of the scholarship will be \$500.00 and will be awarded in a lump sum. Two \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded each year.
- (2) The scholarship is to be used to cover the cost of tuition and/or books.

- (3) The name of the scholarship will be Piedmont McDuffie Auxiliary Scholarship for Health-Related Careers.
- (4) The amount of the scholarship and the number of scholarships awarded may be changed as deemed necessary by the Auxiliary at Piedmont McDuffie.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

The applicant shall complete all required application forms and submit these to the Piedmont McDuffie Scholarship Committee. The Piedmont McDuffie Auxiliary will be notified by the Director of Volunteer Services the names of the applicants that are being considered for the scholarship.

The applicant must meet the deadline of APRIL 1 as specified in the application.

METHOD OF PAYMENT:

The scholarship monies shall be paid directly to the recipient.

OBLIGATIONS:

- (1) The recipient is required to submit to the Director of Volunteer Services of Piedmont McDuffie within 15 days a copy of his/her grades for the semester that the scholarship is used.

PAYMENT:

There is no repayment obligation attached to this scholarship.
